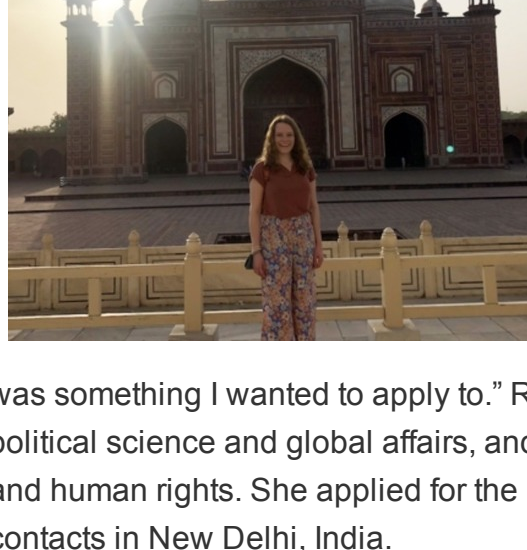

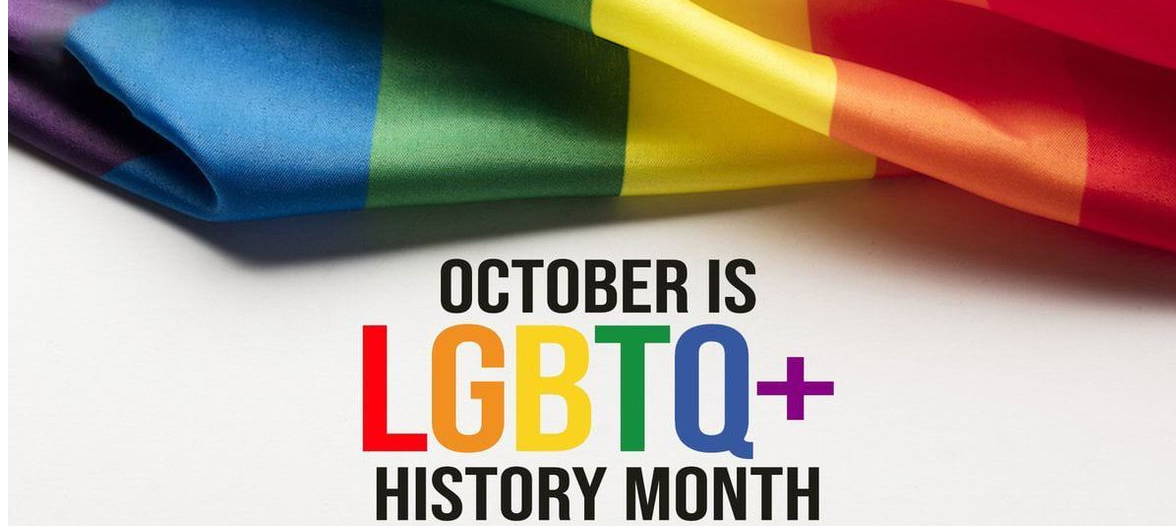


**GPE student conducts healthcare research and takes an active role in adjusting to Indian culture!**

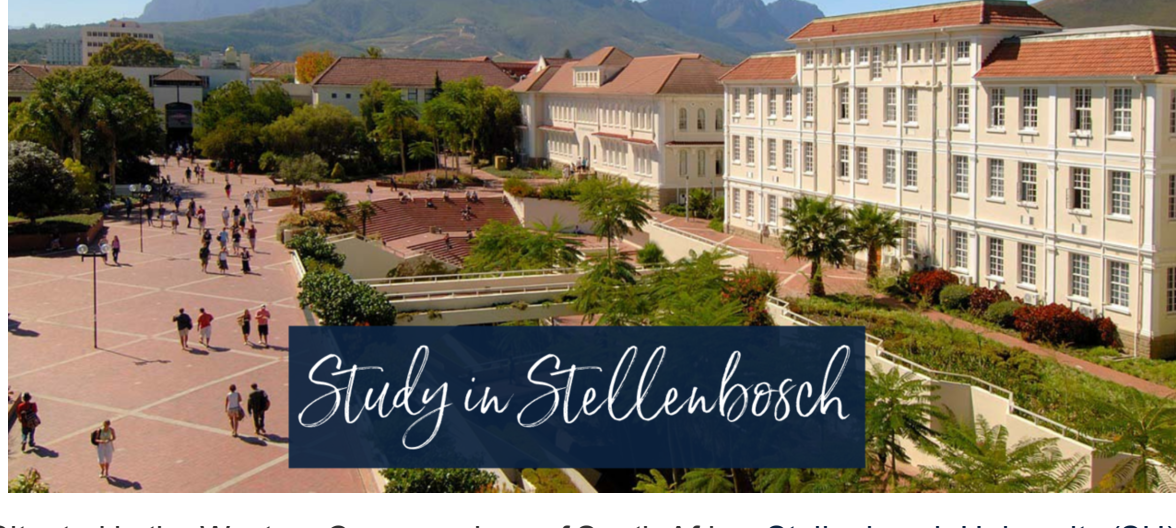
